

WICKLOW PONY CLUB CAMP 2010 SAFETY RULES

1. A railway line runs by the camp fields and access to the camp is via an unguarded level crossing. A railway officer will be on duty from 8:30am to 5:00pm and his instructions must be followed at all times. If for any reason he is not there only cross when you have the green light and make sure there is sufficient space on the other side of the line for your vehicle and box.
2. The Phillips' house, yard and avenue are totally private. Please respect all no entry signs.
3. Children not taking part in camp must be under the supervision of a competent adult at all times. Please note that if any children are found playing near the railway lines or in any of the out of bounds areas they (and their family) will be suspended from camp for the remainder of the week.
4. Dogs can spook ponies. Please don't bring your dogs. Some of the rides are very young and it is not fair to put them in danger.
5. Children must at all times obey the instructions of their instructor and the committee.
6. During breaks from riding children must be supervised by a competent adult.
7. Ponies must walk when moving between arenas and children may not jump any of the cross-country fences unless accompanied by their instructor.
8. Ponies must be given drinks at breaks and may only be tied to boxes if there is a competent adult present and in charge of the pony.
9. Ponies must not be left in trailers that are not secured to a vehicle unless the trailer is properly secured.
10. If any adult observes dangerous behaviour by children please make sure that you put a stop to the behaviour and then immediately notify a committee member most of whom are wearing red tops.
